3. Purposes and Legal Basis for Processing

Your data is processed on the basis of Article 6(1)(b), (c), and (f) of the GDPR in conjunction with Sections 238 et seq. of the German Commercial Code (HGB) and Sections 140 et seq. of the German Fiscal Code (AO).

4. Categories of personal data processed

Green Legal Impact Germany e.V. processes the following categories of your personal data:

- Contact information
- Bank account information
- Transactions
- Personal information, to the extent that you provide it to us in further communications. In doing so, we are guided by the principle of data minimization and do not store particularly sensitive data under any circumstances (Art. 9 GDPR).

5. Recipients or categories of recipients of the personal data

Your personal data will be transferred to: FundraisingBox / Wikando GmbH (data processor). Our service provider for our CRM system has access to the data.

6. Transfer of Personal Data to a Third Country

We do not plan to transfer your personal data to a third country or an international organization.

Your data is provided via a web application on the Internet. Consequently, the confidentiality, integrity, authenticity, and availability of the personal data cannot be conclusively guaranteed. Your data may also be accessed via the web application in third countries that do not have data protection regulations comparable to those of the Federal Republic of Germany.

7. Retention Period for Personal Data

Once collected by Green Legal Impact Germany e.V., your data will be retained for as long as necessary to fulfill the relevant tasks (including processing the donation and maintaining accurate accounting records), in accordance with the statutory retention periods set forth in Section 257 of the German Commercial Code (HGB) and Section 147 of the German Fiscal Code (AO).

8. Data Subject Rights

Under the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), you have the following rights:

If your personal data is being processed, you have the right to access the data stored about you (Art. 15 GDPR).

If inaccurate personal data is being processed, you have the right to have it corrected (Art. 16 GDPR).

If the legal requirements are met, you may request the erasure or restriction of processing, as well as object to the processing (Art. 17, 18, and 21 GDPR).

If you have consented to the data processing or a contract for data processing exists and the data processing is carried out using automated means, you may have a right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR).

Should you exercise your rights as described above, Green Legal Impact Germany e.V. will verify whether the legal requirements for doing so are met.
